As the largest and most recognised clinical study organisation in the world, Synexus provide a friendly relaxed environment where you may have the opportunity to help medical developments.

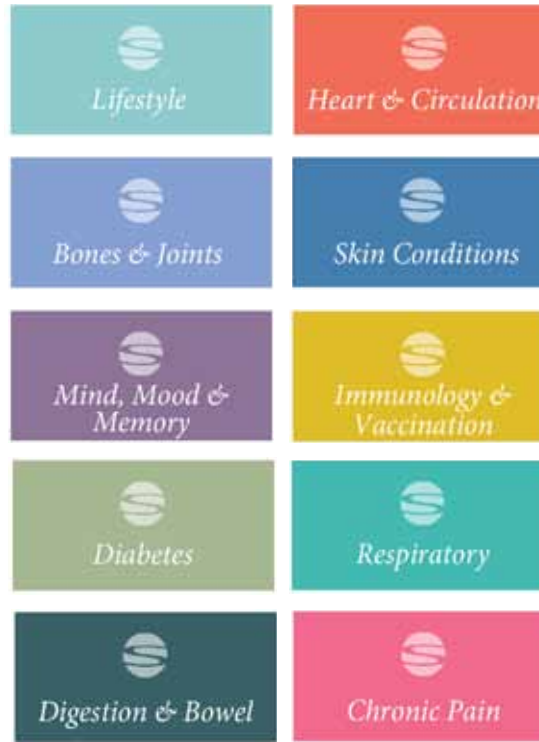
Synexus Thames Valley
